ELIGIBILITY

Up to two awards will be presented to individuals providing community services to underserved individuals in the Capital Region.

CRITERIA

Persons being nominated for this award will have consistently demonstrated qualities of compassion, and service to either one organization or a variety of volunteer activities in one year. The charitable activities/events or services listed on the application cannot be part of the nominee's job description or duties and the individual cannot receive any monetary or personal benefits from their involvement.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- The degree to which their services/actions have made a lasting or meaningful contribution or impact on their community;
- The length and degree of their service(s);
- The extent to which their service or action might be considered above and beyond the call of duty;
- The extent to which their action would be recognized and valued by their peers/ community leaders.
